Welcome to the soil of Indigenous Reconciliation Ministries of the SDACC. We look forward to nurturing your calling to build reconciliatory relationships with Indigenous Communities. We hope to collaborate with you in an authentic healing journey of **learning, growing, and serving** through the **ministry of reconciliation**.

Engaging in service through a **reconciliation approach** may feel challenging at times. Yet we believe that God's people, **rooted in faithful critical contextualization of Biblical truth and transformative grace**, guided by the **light of the Holy Spirit**, will produce a **mighty harvest** when we learn to **plant, nurture, and expand** in the ministry of reconciliation.

The acronym **SEED** encompasses our approach to this process. It stands for **Service Engagement, Evaluation & Development**. We want to nurture you as Constituent Ministry Partners (CMP) - members, churches and schools - in your efforts to build meaning partnerships with First Nations, Inuit & Métis People in whose traditional territory you serve.

The **SEED Planning Process** includes:

1. **Service Engagement:** Register your ministry with the SDACC IRM Department by completing this online form. This provides helpful information that will help us better understand you and support you more effectively.

3. **Evaluation:** Registered CMP will receive support to evaluate their vision, opportunities and approach to building healing relations with Indigenous Communities through the ministry of reconciliation. This may include a live interview with the SDACC IRM Directors. The Indigenous Advisory Council of the IRM Department will use a consistent evaluation rubric to produce a **Reflection Report** to the CMP that offers both quantitative insights and qualitative reflections.

5. **Development Planning:** In addition to the Reflection Report, an **IRM Development Plan** will be issued to the CMP. This plan outlines practical steps to strengthen areas identified for growth and to deepen the effectiveness of reconciliation-focused ministry. CMP who actively engage with their IRM Development Plan will receive ongoing support, special training and access to special funding opportunities to develop their ministries.

The SDACC IRM is committed to equipping & mobilizing a growing network of members, churches and schools invested in the ministry of reconciliation with Indigenous People.
